This is fitted with hoists, privacy screens, adult-sized changing benches, a peninsula toilet and has space for carers. Please ask staff in Junglies Gift Shop for the radar key, or please feel free to use your own.'

Disabled toilets are available on the end of the Admissions Building (largest building with a wavy roof). On a busy day this area becomes congested with traffic, so please enter the park via Husborne Crawley gate MK43 0XB and park safely alongside these toilets, without blocking access for keeper vehicles.

Your next toilets are located after you finish the Road Safari, which may take around 60-90 minutes. See details on the Road Safari map.
