Licence conditions (required by section 1A of the Act):

Woburn Safari Park must ensure that the following measures are implemented in the Zoo:

1. Promoting public education and awareness in relation to the conservation of biodiversity, in particular by providing information about the species of wild animals kept in the Zoo and their natural habitats.
2. Accommodating and keeping the animals in a manner which meets the standards set out in the Secretary of State's Standards of Modern Zoo Practice (SSSMZP).
3. Preventing the escape of animals and putting in place measures to be taken in the event of any escape or unauthorised release of animals.
4. Participate in at least one of the following:
 - a) research from which conservation benefits accrue to species of wild animals;
 - b) training in relevant conservation skills;
 - c) the exchange of information relating to the conservation of species of wild animals;
 - d) where appropriate, breeding of wild animals in captivity; and
 - e) where appropriate, the repopulation of an area with, or the reintroduction into the wild of, wild animals.

Additional conditions

5. Escapes

- a) In the event of any non-domestic animal escaping from the confines of the zoo, Woburn Safari Park shall notify Central Bedfordshire Council as soon as possible, and, in any case, not later than 24 hours following the escape.
- b) In the event of any animal listed in the SSSMZP in Category 1 of the Hazardous Animal Categorisation (see Appendix 12 of SSSMZP) escaping from its primary enclosure, Woburn Safari Park shall notify Central Bedfordshire Council as soon as possible, and, in any case, not later than 24 hours following the escape.
